An ordinance of Upson County, Georgia to amend the code of Upson County, Amending Chapter 84 The Telecommunication Ordinance and Appendix A – Zoning; Modifying the definition of Tower; Adding & applying Amateur Radio Facilities to the ordinance; Exempting Amateur Radio Station Operators & facilities from certain provisions; Deleting “Conditional Use” Terminology; Requiring Certified Equipment Use: Applying setback requirements; Addressing structural additions that create additional height; Adding wireless communications facilities and/or amateur radio antenna & support structures as principal and/or accessory permitted uses in the A-R, R-1, R-2, R-4, R-5, P-M, P-R, O-1, M-1 & M2 zoning districts; Providing for repeal/conflict; providing for severability; providing for an effective date.

The SPX2021-01 applicant is William T. Reeves of Thomaston, Georgia. Mr. Reeves has requested an A-R special exception for a 250 s.f. family cemetery use at 1193 Allen Road. The 29.4 acre parent parcel is more referred to as being in Land Lot 277 and 278 of the 1st Land District and found on Tax Map 089 Parcel 090.
