

### Marriage License Application Requirements & Fees

- Valid photo ID (Proof of residency may be required if drivers' license does not have correct physical address) (Proof of residency would include a voter registration card, a lease or rental agreement, a current tax return, or a valid GA drivers' license with correct physical address)
- Certified copy of Birth Certificate (Must have raised seal)
- Final Decree of Divorce of most recent marriage,  
(Must have Judge's signature and court seal)  
OR  
Certified copy of Death Certificate of most recent marriage (Must have raised seal)
- The Law does not allow anyone under the age of 18 to marry.
- Both applicants must be present at the time of application.

Application Fees - with Counseling (Must provide signed certificate showing 6 hours of counseling)	-	\$16.00

Total Due at Time of Application	=	<b>\$36.00</b>

Certified Copies of Marriage Record	-	\$20.00
Frame-able Certificate	-	\$10.00

**\*\* All fees can be paid with cash, money order or credit/debit card (no personal checks).**

**\*\*\* We process applications Monday, Wednesday, Thursday, & Friday 8:00 a.m. -11:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. Both parties must be present to apply for a marriage license. Our office does not perform wedding ceremonies.**

- You may complete your marriage license application online before your scheduled appointment time. This will shorten the length of time you will have to wait for your license in our office.

- When you submit the application, you will receive a confirmation number. Bring the confirmation with you when you come in to apply.
